



Centerpiece & Décor Removal

The Grandview **DOES NOT** breakdown, remove, or cleanup any centerpieces, floral arrangements, candles, or any décor brought in for your event. The individual, florist, decorator, or company responsible for setting up these items is also responsible for collecting and removing them at the conclusion of the event.

If a florist or decorator has been hired and does not remove the items at the end of the event, those items **MUST** be packed up by the client, who will be responsible for taking them home that evening.

The client is responsible for making arrangements in advance to ensure that all items are collected and removed from the property before departing the event. At the conclusion of the evening, the client will sign off confirming that all personal items, centerpieces, and décor have been removed from the premises.

All centerpieces, candles, décor, personal items, and other materials brought onto the property must be removed from the premises at the conclusion of the event. Nothing may be left behind for pickup at a later date. The Grandview does not have storage available for any items remaining after the event and cannot accommodate next-day pickups.

If The Grandview staff is requested or required to break down, collect, pack, or remove centerpieces, candles, floral arrangements, or décor at the conclusion of the event, additional service fees will apply. This service is not included in the event package and will be billed to the client based on the extent of the work required.
